PROMOTION/RETENTION

Junior High

In order to be promoted to the next grade level, each junior high school student (grades 7 and 8) must pass with a "D" or better twelve (12) of the fourteen (14) semester grades which are given during the year.

In order to be promoted or to be graduated, each junior high school student must not receive more than a total of two (2) failing semester grades during the school year.

At the beginning of the school year, each junior high parent will be notified by letter of the criteria for promotion.

At the end of the first semester, a letter will be sent to all parents of students who have received any failing grades in order to insure that they are aware of the situation and the need for assisting their son/daughter if (s)he is to be promoted to the next grade.
