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Meet the New Staff


We are pleased to introduce our two new staff members!



Family Access

Dear Parent or Guardian,

The School Board, administration and staff at Mary M. Knight recognizes that many parents would like to play a greater role in their child's education. To make it easier to be involved, we are providing you with the ability to view your child's information at any time. Parents can view their child's Schedule, Assignments, Grades, Attendance, Food Service, and Student information- address, phone number, emergency contact, and health alerts.

The software that makes this possible is Skyward's Family Access. Family Access is available through a link on the district web site http://marymknightcom or through a remote app you can install on your phone. To use this software you will need to have a username and password assigned to you. To receive your username and password, please fill out the application form located on the district website: http://marymknightcom under the parent/student tab, registration, under forms on the right side of the page. Your username and password will work for all children in your household thus you will only need to fill out one application. Your application will be processed within 10 days of receipt and a letter and/or email with your login information will be sent to you.

Your username and password should work flawlessly, in the event you should have a problem, you can email me at kbrehmeyer@mmk.wednet.edu or call the school at 360.426.6767 ext. 101. A reply to your request will be sent as soon as possible.
